### Take away four units of work, and the skills to develop more:

#### 1) Science and technology, literacy, numeracy and digital competency

Using scientific enquiry based on your local area, make links with the rest of the world, offering opportunities for communication on a local, national and global scale.

#### 2) Expressive arts, literacy, numeracy and digital competency

Drawing on quality literature, use drama techniques to develop students' understanding of challenging texts and find out how numeracy can be embedded through film and digital technologies.

#### 3) Humanities, literacy, numeracy and digital competency

Combining the work of great Welsh writers with geographic data and historical data, look at how the humanities subjects offer inspiring opportunities for rich tasks within a Welsh context.

#### 4) Health and well-being, literacy, numeracy and digital competency

Considering national data, fiction and non-fiction texts as well as film documentary, create your own teaching tool that can be used in the classroom tomorrow.
